

OpenTable Diners Reveal the Hottest Restaurants in the U.S.

In a Nod Toward OpenTable Diners' Love of Trying New Restaurants, One-Third of the Top 50 Hottest Restaurants Opened Within the Past Year

The Twin Cities received twin honors, with two restaurants earning places on the list. Other cities with wins include Boston, Charleston, Cincinnati, Portland, and Scottsdale, among others.
